Code Requirements for Structural Integrity - Webinar

Since the collapse of the twin World Trade Center Towers in New York, the ICC has been under pressure to adopt building code provisions to prevent disproportionate collapse or progressive collapse.

In 2006, NCSEA formed a joint ad hoc industry committee to develop such provisions. The committee determined that the code and referenced standards already had substantial protection against disproportionate collapse but did not put forward a proposal to make the requirements for buildings of different construction types more consistent.

This proposal has now been adopted into the 2009 International Building Code. This webinar will provide an overview of the Structural Integrity criteria contained in the 2009 IBC and referenced standards, and contrast these with criteria enforced by several federal agencies.

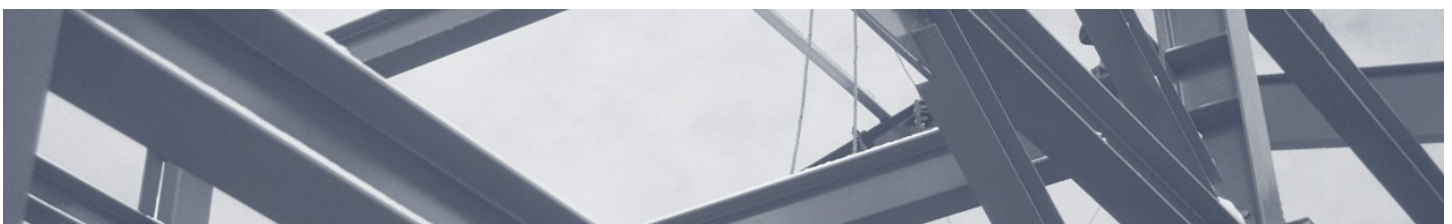
